## Presentations

### **Karla Baker, GIS Developer with the City of Boise – VueWorks Mobile Application**

- Karla Baker demonstrated the City of Boise's VueWorks mobile application. VueWorks is an asset management system; the mobile application allows staff track tasks spatially in the field. The City of Boise uses it to track storm drains, streetlights, fire hydrants, government buildings, and is currently being used by the Airport, the Parks Department, the Fire Department, and Public Works.

### **Katey Jones, GIS Analyst with the City of Meridian – SXBlue II + GPS and ArcPad**

- Katey Jones demonstrated the SXBlue II + GPS and ArcPad. The City of Meridian uses the SXBlue II + GPS, a sub-meter GPS that can also be a real-time receiver. The SXBlue II + GPS is lightweight, ruggedized and waterproof. Meridian uses the SXBlue II to GPS

new construction at Meridian's WWRF. The software Meridian's use to capture the GPS points is ArcPad.
